We have close to 500 children from 25 schools within the Dallas Independent School District, housing projects and community centers. Some of the children are from areas of town that are the least likely to be considered for classical ballet training. But these children are proof that dance, just like music, can transcend through even the poorest

socioeconomic barriers. They are in dire need of a home. They are asking if anyone has an interest in donating a warehouse/building/permanent dance floor space for a period of time for their dancers (children ages 3 - high school). They are in the middle of their 2006 - eight week Summer Intensive Professional Fine Arts Training Camp, which is housed at Holy Cross Catholic Church 2926 E. Ledbetter Drive, Dallas, Texas 75216. Classes are Mon-Thurs 9:00am to 2:00pm. Their Fine Arts Summer Showcase is July 30, 2006 at the Dallas Fair Park Women's Museum, a 2:00 pm nattinee, which promises to be a memorable event.
